- 3A He appealed to King Artxerxes of Persia to go rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.
- 4A This woman led Israel as a prophet and a judge at a time when it was not popular.
- 5A A prophetess in Jerusalem who spoke the truth that God had given her to the king's men when he sent them to seek counsel with her.
- 6A Killed a lion and a bear as a young shepherd boy protecting his flock.
- 7A She risked her life by approaching King Xerxes and revealing that she was a Jew–so that she could help her people.
